For the past 25 years, the State Toxicology Laboratory (STL) has provided quality and efficient service to the law enforcement community. Over the past 10 years, the STL has received over 137,000 specimens from over 550 law enforcement agencies around the State, resulting in over 960,000 individual drug tests. The STL provides low cost, accurate drug testing results in accordance with the Attorney General's Law Enforcement Drug Testing Guidelines.

Now, in addition to law enforcement drug testing, the STL is offering drug testing of non-law enforcement personnel. Agencies who wish to have their applicants, trainees, and/or employees tested for drugs will have the opportunity to do so at a low cost. Possible participants include, but are not limited to, fire fighters (career and volunteer), EMT/EMS technicians, mobile intensive care paramedics, state and municipal employees, unarmed security personnel, and school athletes (high school and college).

The State Toxicology Laboratory can provide testing for the following eight specific classes of drugs: amphetamine/methamphetamine, barbiturates, benzodiazepine, cannabinoids, cocaine, methadone, phencyclidine, opiates.

To ensure quality of service, proficiency programs to monitor all aspects of the laboratory service have been developed. The laboratory maintains active continuing education, research and development programs. Future projects include a new laboratory information system and improvements to the current test menu.

The ELISA Drugs of Abuse Testing

The **EVO 75 Freedom** is used for screening biological specimens for therapeutic and drugs of abuse. The **ELISA** technique allows for lower sensitivity and specificity for compounds not normally detected by standard screening techniques and in addition to expanding many screening capabilities. This equipment could potentially test up to 12 different drugs from a single test specimen.

The common carrier processes multiple sample types, calibration and quality control material to reduce sample sorting. It delivers 1200 tests per hour (up to 800 photometric and 600 ISE) with the state-of-the-art immunochemistry platform which allows for greater productivity and faster response time.
